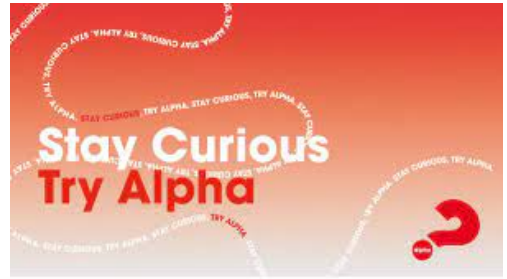


Alpha @ St James'

WHAT IS ALPHA? The Alpha Course is an opportunity for anyone to explore the Christian faith in a relaxed, non-threatening manner over 8 thought provoking weekly sessions. It's low key, friendly and fun, and supported by all the main Christian denominations.

WHY ATTEND THE ALPHA COURSE? Guests come on the Alpha course for many different reasons; some want to investigate whether God exists and some have questions they'd like to discuss. Some guests may have never been to church and others may have attended church all of their lives but feel they have never had a personal understanding of the Christian faith. Everyone is welcome.

HOW ALPHA WORKS Alpha is based around groups of 6-8 people, led by one or two hosts whose role is to facilitate and encourage discussion. It's a place where people can come and relax, eat, share thoughts and explore the meaning of life. The course consists of 9 weekly sessions. Each session begins by sharing a meal together, then a short talk looking at a different aspect of the Christian faith each week. This is followed by a time of discussion where guests can ask questions and contribute their opinion.

There is no charge to attend the Alpha course, but guests may make a contribution toward the food if they wish.
